Orientation Day Itinerary for Students and Parents

If you have not yet completed the on-line registration process through MyPaymentsPlus, go first to the CLC to complete this step (there are staff to assist you). Then, proceed as described below.

If you did complete the on-line registration process at home or have just completed it in the CLC, follow these steps.

1. Go to the North Gwinnett webpage and enter your student number in the designated area to find your 1st period class. The 1st period locations will be available after 9:00 pm on Wednesday, August 1st.
2. Report to your 1st period class.
3. In your 1st period class, you will:
 - Meet your first period teacher.
 - Receive your schedule.
 - Receive other important information.
4. Any student who has an incomplete schedule or has a sticker on his/her schedule should follow the directions on where to report for corrections. **No other schedule changes will be made.**
5. Go to your other classes and meet your teachers.
6. **Visit the Commons Area:**
 - Parents: Make sure you register for **Parent Portal** if you have not already done so. If you registered in the past, you do not have register again, your log-in will move with you.
 - Visit with counselors to answer questions.
 - Get information on the lunch program (including free and reduced lunches)
 - Get bus information if needed.
 - Parking: Seniors who prepaid and Juniors who were contacted after being chosen in the lottery (from applications turned in by June 20th) may pick up parking passes during Junior and Senior time slots. You must have a valid driver's license (or photocopy) to pick up the pass.
 - Pick up pre-paid Bulldog Cards (purchase on MyPaymentsPlus)
 - Visit the PTSA and Community School tables to learn about their programs.
 - Pay for a locker and optional contributions if not paid online.
 - Pay for any lost textbooks or fees
 - Purchase football tickets or season passes
 - Pick up pre-paid or purchase an agenda book
 - Learn about school communication tools
7. Visit the New Gym to find information about Clubs, Teams, and Organizations
8. Visit our school store, The Dawg House, to purchase new NGHS spirit wear
9. Other information you need to know:
 - Student IDs will not be distributed today. IDs will be made from school pictures taken early in the school year and distributed after that time.
 - Locker combinations will be given out through 1st period teachers on Monday to all students who have pre-paid.

For Students Whose Parents Drive Them to/from School

****For the safety of your student and others, there should NEVER be a student picked up or dropped off in the middle or side of the roads surrounding NGHS.****

The entrance to Theater/Gym parking lot off of Suwanee Dam Road is for employee parking only. For student safety reasons, **NO other vehicles are permitted in that parking lot between 6am and 3pm.**

After 2:30pm, students who are not supervised by a teacher and/or coach after school must wait for their rides at the front of the school only.

DROP OFF in morning: There is no drop off in any of our parking lots or on the side/middle of any of our surrounding streets. Student drop off is located in the front circle off Level Creek Road with a right turn only out of the front circle area. Form 2 lines for drop off. Those arriving going south on Level Creek should turn right into the drive and form a lane on the school side of the drive. Those traveling north on Level Creek should turn left into the drive and be in lane on the parking side of the circle. When traffic naturally stops let your student exit the car.

PICK UP

2:10: Parent pick up is located in the student parking lot off Level Creek Road. To pick up your student pull into the lot **take an immediate right, do not park in the first two rows** and

1. Follow the perimeter of the lot until you reach the pick-up line where you wait for your student to come to you **OR**
2. After the right turn go past the first 2 rows and find a parking place where you wait for your student **OR**
3. If your student is in the waiting area by the softball field stop, pick them up, proceed around to the middle isle and exit

After 2:30: Students may be picked up in the front circle. Please enter and form 2 lines (if needed) **with an exit lane in between.**

- Visitor parking spots are not for after school student pick up
- Reserved parking places are for designated person only
- No student pick up in the baseball lot from 2:10-2:30
